

# THE NEXT GENERATION IN WOUND DRESSINGS



**Day 1**

**Incision 4.0 x 0.1 cm**

**Ulceration is 2.0 x 2.0 x 1.2 cm deep**

**Day 44**

## **Patient Summary**

68-year-old non-diabetic patient was seen in-hospital for initial consultation for non-healing wound to the right foot. Patient was unable to relate further information regarding the wound, however, he had stated that he had problems walking and was complaining of rest pain. Patient underwent interventional angioplasty, which showed occlusion of the peroneal artery of the right leg.

## **Clinical Course**

Patient was operated on for osteomyelitis of the 5th metatarsal. Patient was placed on negative pressure wound therapy for two weeks, SilvrSTAT<sup>®</sup> placed into the wound and protecting the incision on the foot using collagen dermal template with ECM. Wound completely epithelialized by post op day 44. Note the integrity of the incision dorsally without large evidence of adhesional scarring or fibrosis.
